

Dear Mr Alex Salmond,

First of all I would like to thank you for your hard work for Scotland and its people. It must have been a disappointment regarding the outcome the Scottish Independence, albeit this has been an eye opener to those who have all along closed their eyes to politics and the views in Scotland.

After hearing several people on the radio talking about your service to Scotland, no one has mentioned the following points.
